

CONTRACT

Dr. Daniel Farris Voice Studio

PRIVATE MUSIC INSTRUCTION SESSIONS

I, _____ (hereafter referred to as “the Student”), agree to attend private music instruction sessions with Dr. Daniel Farris (hereafter referred to as “the Professor”), in mutual representation of Dr. Daniel Farris Voice Studio (hereafter referred to as “the Studio”).

These sessions will be held on a bimonthly basis for 50 minutes per lesson.

The tuition for all lessons is \$75 per lesson, which will be paid ahead at the first lesson of each month. I understand that my tuition payments are not refundable under any circumstances, including situations where I cannot attend a lesson and have not made accommodations with the Professor to reschedule. I understand that all terms in this agreement are non-negotiable upon execution of this contract. The Professor has the right to change these circumstances of the contract, and will contact the Student if this is to occur.

The terms of this contract shall be in effect beginning _____ and will end upon termination at the Professor’s or the Student’s notice. All fees paid for a given month in a month where the contract is terminated by the Student are non-refundable. Upon termination by the Professor, the Student will be refunded lesson fees for lessons days that have not occurred.

1. STUDENT RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. Students will arrive on time to all scheduled lessons. Lessons will end at their scheduled end time, regardless of the time of Student’s arrival. Student will not overstay his/her lesson time, or otherwise cut into another student’s lesson time, unless this has been pre-approved by the Professor.
- B. Students will bring a pencil, their scores/books, and all materials disbursed in the lessons.
- C. Tuition for lessons in the month are due at the first lesson of the month. Returned checks or other invalidated monies will result in a fee of \$15 per incident.
- D. If the Student decides to discontinue lessons, notice must be given in the first lesson of the Student’s final month.
- E. The Professor is not responsible for any left materials or personal items in the office.

2. PROFESSOR RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. The Professor shall begin lessons at their scheduled time, or the Professor shall extend the lesson to meet the required lesson duration.
- B. The Professor will usually make MP3 recordings of lessons and upload them via Dropbox to share with the Student.
