

C. In addition to continually developing the Student's repertoire, the Professor will provide appropriate exercises for the Student to practice diligently throughout their week. Singing songs without isolating muscular event through exercise and awareness will not improve technique.

D. The Student will receive safe instruction of vocal technique in a classical style that befits singing in various state auditions. No student is under any obligation to audition if an audition is available, and the Professor is not under any obligation to provide these opportunities to every student. The decision as to whether students are deemed performance-ready for recitals or other public performances or non-OMEA/OSSAA nature will be made at the discretion of the Professor.

E. If the Professor has to cancel a lesson for any reason, the Professor will reschedule.

F. The Professor reserves the right to cancel the Student's contract at any time, in situations where the Student does not maintain ideal Studio standards, specifically regarding:

1. Timeliness
2. Attendance
3. Preparation
4. Professional attitude
5. Improvement and progress

3. INCLEMENT WEATHER AND HOLIDAY CANCELLATION POLICY

Dr. Daniel Farris follows Maughan Studios decisions regarding school delays and cancellations. When the studio closes for inclement weather or a government holiday, the instructor will reschedule a lesson to be held not later than 4 weeks after the initial closure, in order to recuperate lost instructional time. No refunds, deductions or credits will be given to students affected by weather-related or holiday-related closures, regardless of the student's ability to attend the session.
